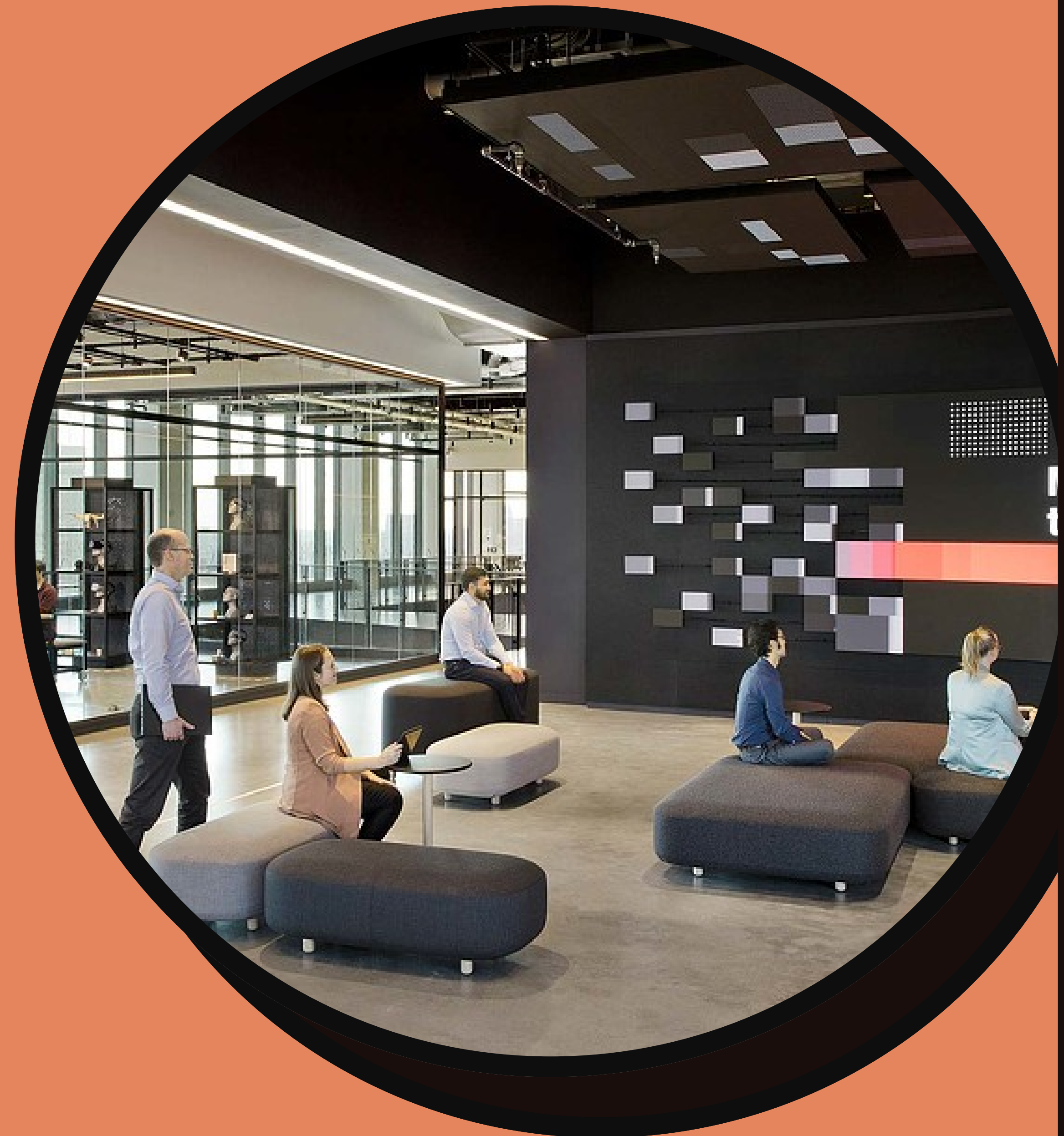

How to enter

01 Select PROJECT

To qualify, students must be currently enrolled or have graduated within the last 12 months from an Interior Design program at a New England College or University (either undergraduate or graduate level).

Participants may submit (1) project for entry. See clarifications regarding team entry vs. individual entry on next page.

03 Collect DOCUMENTATION

Determine all the details needed for showcasing the project details, and characteristics.

02 Create ACCOUNT

PROJECT INFORMATION

Students should use their own judgment to include any additional information necessary to convey the essence of their project within a 5-sheet format.

- Inspiration/Concept
- Floor Plan
- Finishes
- Elevations and/or Rendered Perspectives
- Rendered Perspectives and/or Imagery

Your 250-word (max) description should include a client profile, project objectives, design concept and solutions, design challenges, team contributions, and sustainable and equitable design efforts. It is important to be descriptive yet concise. The narrative should support your project documentation.

Team submissions are to defined as group or team projects where the team was a minimum of (2) individuals and a maximum of (4) individuals. All team member names and contact information shall be included within submission showing consent by all team members to submit. Any project submitted as a team may not be submitted separately by an individual, however, individual team members may submit a different project separately as an individual. Please note your name and information should not be listed on any sheet for judging confidentiality. IIDA New England reserves the right to eliminate any entries that do not meet minimum submission requirements. Each file must be 5MB or less.

TIMELINE

Projects must have been completed during the student's education. Projects previously submitted for the IIDA New England Design Awards will not be accepted.

DESIGNED BY

Student or Student Design Team

New for 2023, student design teams can submit into Student Entries. If a group submission wins, awards will be split evenly between group members.

FORMAT

- 11" x 17"
- Landscape Orientated
- PDF Format

Submit a total of five (5) sheets in one combined PDF. Each sheet size cannot exceed 5MB. High quality pngs of any renderings should be included on project sheets.
